## Frank Keane Fast 4 Winter Series Tournament Rules

- 1. This tournament is a Fast 4 competition, the scoring system is available <u>here</u> or on the noticeboard.
- 2. Players enter the tournament individually based on their current Championship Doubles Ranking, <u>available here</u> or on the notice board. Entry fee is €15 per person.
- 3. Entries are limited to 4 places each for men and ladies in Championship, Band 1 & Band 2 and 8 places each for Band 3. Band 4 & Band 5.
- 4. A total of 72 players will be accommodated on a first come first served basis with entries going live Wednesday 9th at 10am
- 5. The tournament will take place over 8 weekends on Fridays from 7pm and Saturdays from 4.30pm.
- 6. Players will play only 1 night on 6 of the 8 weekends scheduled for play.
- 7. Each discipline, Singles, Doubles and Mixed Doubles will have two rotations and partners are allocated on a random basis. Dates of play are as follows:
  - 1. 11th/12th Oct. Mixed Doubles
  - 2. 18th/19th Oct. Ladies Singles
  - 3. 25th/26th Oct. No Play
  - 4. 1st/2nd Nov. Men's Singles
  - 5. 8th/9th Nov. Ladies Singles
  - 6. 15th/16th Nov. Men's and Ladies Doubles
  - 7. 22nd/23rd Nov. Men's Singles
  - 8. 29th/30th Nov. Men's and Ladies Doubles
  - 9. 7th Dec. Mixed Doubles
- 8. If a player cannot play on a scheduled night a sub of the same doubles band ranking must be found by the player. If a sub of the same doubles band cannot be found you may use a player of a lower doubles band only.
- 9. Ineligible subs shall forfeit all points scored and rule 11 shall apply.
- 10. Any score accumulated by a sub shall have 6 points deducted from their total points on the night.
- 11. Failure to provide a sub will result in zero points being scored on the night with unopposed players being awarded 4 points. In doubles, players who do not have a partner to contest a match shall receive 2 points.
- 12. Play will be in round robin groups of 4 with everyone playing each other twice on the night, totalling 6 sets.
- 13. Scoring: 1 point shall be awarded for each game won on the night and minus 1 point for each game lost. The winner within each band classification shall be the person who has the largest nett differential of points. In the event of a tie the winner shall be decided by whom ever has won the most sets, then games and if still tied then the most 4-0 wins and so on through to the most 4-2 wins. In the event of there still being a tie the winner shall be decided by lot.
- 14. In mixed doubles at deuce point the man shall serve to the man and similarly the lady to lady.
- 15. In doubles at deuce point the receiver chooses who will receive the ball.
- 16. No change of ends in tie breaker, first to 5 points.
- 17. There are weekly prizes for highest points scorers in each band.
- 18. Overall men's and ladies winners shall receive a prize and the use of a brand new BMW for one weekend each in January 2020.
- 19. Prize giving will happen immediately after play on Finals Night 7th December.
- 20. All committee decisions are final.
